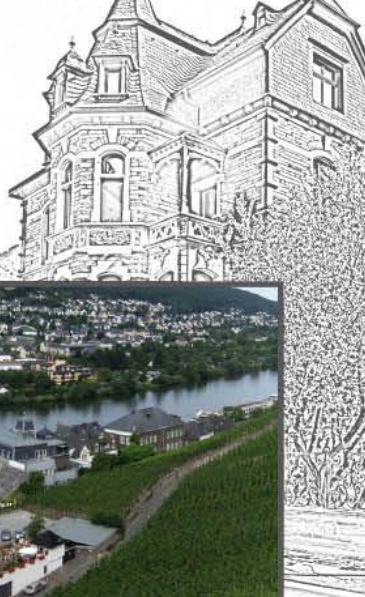

NOBLE HOUSE

The NOBLE HOUSE was named in honour of the Prince Elect of Trier, the oldest city of Germany. He built this distinguished NOBLE HOUSE in 1743. His winery was located inside this building. Here his grapes were pressed and his wines were made. The grandfather of Dr. Peter Pauly, Zacharias Bergweiler-Prüm, bought the house about 100 years ago.

Description

Noble House Dornfelder is made from 100% Dornfelder grapes. Dornfelder is a grape similar to Merlot or Sangiovese, making a very fruity and light wine. This wine is made in stainless steel tanks, resulting in an easy-drinking wine which is comparable to "Beaujolais" or "Chianti".

Suggestion

The taste of the Noble House Dornfelder is characterized by intense fruity aromas of cherries and red berries. It is a low alcohol medium-bodied young red wine with an excellent up front fruity flavor that lingers on the palate. It is a fantastic wine for Pasta Bolognese. Also goes well with duck breast and red cabbage, and works even for dessert (homemade brownies with vanilla ice cream).
